







 Greater Impact on large and micro enterprises


#### **ECONOMIC RECOVERY SLOWS DOWN IN THIRD QUARTER**

UK growth slowed from 5.5% in Q2 (March to June) to 1.3% in Q3 (July to September)

Economic growth in Q3 driven by consumer services (hospitality, arts & recreation) and health

Evidence of further slowdown in consumer sentiment and spending

#### RECOVERY HAS ENTERED MORE CHALLENGING PHASE


5<sup>th</sup> consecutive decrease in retail sales in September


Business activity stronger than expected in October

#### Business activity and new orders – South East





### Growth in resident employment




- **Sector changes**

- Falling employment → admin & support; wholesale & retail, accommodation & food, professional services, manufacturing


- +15,200 payrolled employees (residents in employment) in Q3, +2% on previous quarter and 3.7% on the year

### Monthly change in unemployment – September 2021 (Claimant Count Unemployment)




# Unemployment rates – September 2021 (Claimant Count Unemployment)




- 27,000 claimants, 2.9% rate (the lowest in the area); down 3,500 or -0.3pp over Q3 2021
- 4600 young claimants (18-24 year olds), 3.9% rate, down 970 or -0.8pp over Q3 2021





- Strong demand for green jobs, particularly sustainability consultants and environmental occupations (e.g. environmental consultants, engineers, and managers).
- By Mid-November green jobs demand was 180% above last year's levels reflecting not only post lockdowns but rising climate agenda boosted by prominence of COP26.

### **BUSINESS UPDATES IN ENTERPRISE M3**

### **BUSINESS NEWS HEADLINES**

**US logistics giant to invest £1.5bn into zero-carbon warehouses**. Global logistics firm Prologis will plough around £1.5bn into the development of new zero-carbon warehouses in England. The San Francisco-based firm said the fund, to be invested over the next three years, will support around 14,000 jobs in London, South East and the Midlands.

**Talkwalker expands with Surrey acquisition**. Discover.ai, a Surrey-headquartered cultural insight platform, has been snapped up by national counterpart Talkwalker. Discover.ai has worked with some of the world's largest brands with more than 800 insights projects across 30 countries.

A major letting at the Space development in Woking has been struck. ID Business Solutions – which will move from Guildford on completion of the fit-out in January 2022 – has snapped up the entire sixth and seventh floors, totalling 19,490 sq ft.

A Kent-headquartered **records management business has been acquired by a Surrey counterpart** in a deal worth £6.5m. The Document Warehouse generates annual revenue of £550,000. It will provide an additional site with capacity to service the key London and the South markets for acquirer Restore's growing estate. It is the sixth acquisition by Restore this year.

**Two new cardiac labs to open at Basingstoke hospital** in 2022. The trust which runs Basingstoke hospital has confirmed the expansion of its cardiology services with the construction of two new cardiac catheterisation labs.

Elmbridge fencing firms set to lose 25 jobs as plans for housing on Cobham Green Belt site are passed. Plans have been passed that will see up to 25 people lose their jobs as a commercial site in Cobham will be turned into 27 residential dwellings.

#### **BUSINESS NEWS HEADLINES**

Farnborough-headquartered self-storage company Lok'nStore extends banking facilities by £25m. The increased facility will provide additional headroom to underpin the funding for Lok'nStore's pipeline of 13 secured stores.

**Care company Home Instead with clients in Surrey announces 50 carer vacancies**. The roles are based in Runnymede, West Spelthorne and Windsor.
